## Tires

The proper disposal of tires will prevent the contamination of ground water and reduce breeding grounds for disease carrying mosquitoes. Tires <u>may not</u> be put in the trash and must be dropped off to be recycled. A small or large quantity of tires which include unconventional type tires can be dropped off at Emanuel Tire of PA for a fee. A <u>scrap and metal</u> facility will accept metal rims <u>without tires</u>. The following tire retailers will take old tires and rims for a recycling fee. <u>Creamery Tire</u> - accepts conventional tires in a small quantity. Emanuel Tire of PA - accepts all type tires in a small or large quantity. Location: Plymouth Township
